Finished Size: 12" square

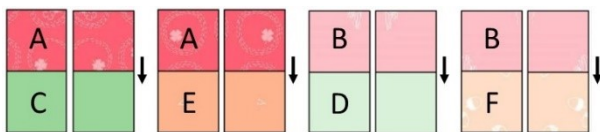
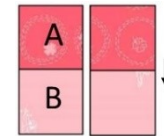
Skill level: Confident beginner

Fabrics used: FIGO Fabrics' Lucky Charms and Northcott's ColorWorks #9000 cotton broadcloth

Fabric	Cutting Instructions
A – dark pink (#92004-23)	◇ Cut (3) 5" x 2½" pieces
B – medium pink (#92001-21)	◇ Cut (3) 5" x 2½" pieces
C – medium green (#9000-731)	◇ Cut (1) 5" x 2½" piece and (2) 2½" squares
D – pale green (#9000-752)	◇ Cut (1) 5" x 2½" piece and (2) 2½" squares
E – peach (#92000-22)	◇ Cut (1) 5" x 2½" piece and (2) 2½" squares
F – yellow (#92002-20)	◇ Cut (1) 5" x 2½" piece and (2) 2½" squares
G – vanilla ground (#92005-11)	◇ Cut (4) 4½" x 2½" pieces

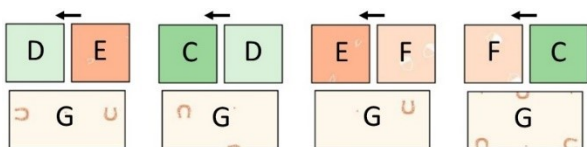
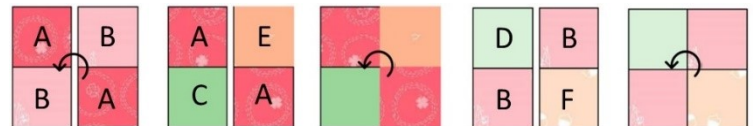
Piecing: All seams are ¼" unless noted. Press seams in direction of arrows.

1. Sew a Fabric A piece to a Fabric B piece along long edge. Cut into (2) 2½" sections.



2. Repeat with the following pieces: A-C, A-E, B-D, B-F

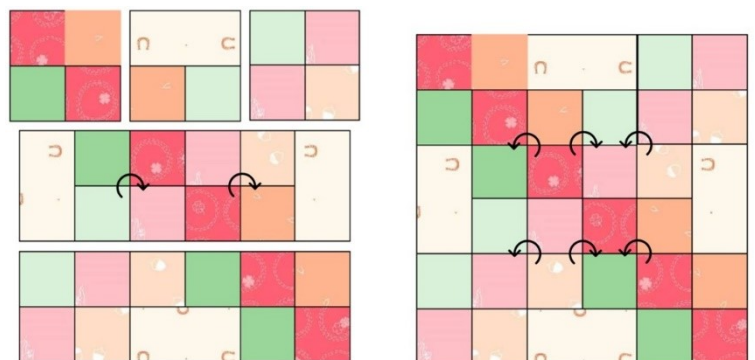
3. Sew the sections together in pairs, making (1) A-B/A-B unit, (2) A-E/C-A units and (2) D-B/B-F units.



4. Sew the remaining C, D, E and F squares in pairs as shown.

5. Sew each section from step 4 to a G piece as shown; press seam away from G.

6. Arrange the step 3 units and step 5 units in a 3x3 grid as shown; sew into rows, then sew the rows together.



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
