



Rosebud Wreath

Finished Size: 12" square

Skill level: Intermediate

Fabrics used: Northcott's *Toscana* suede-look cotton

Fabric	Cutting Instructions
A – wine (#9020-281)	◇ Cut (4) 2" x 1¼" pieces (1A), (4) 1¼" squares (2A), (4) 1½" x 1" pieces (3A) & (4) 1" squares (4A)
B – crimson (#9020-240)	◇ Cut (4) 2¾" x 1¼" pieces (1B), (8) 2" x 1¼" pieces (2B), (4) 1¼" squares (3B), (4) 2" x 1" pieces (4B), (8) 1½" x 1" pieces (5B) & (4) 1" squares (6B)
C – rose (#9020-241)	◇ Cut (4) 3½" x 1¼" pieces (1C), (8) 2¾" x 1¼" pieces (2C), (4) 2" x 1¼" pieces (3C), (4) 2" x 1" pieces (4C) & (4) 1½" x 1" pieces (5C)
D – blush (#9020-221)	◇ Cut (4) 3½" x 1¼" pieces (1D) & (4) 2¾" x 1¼" pieces (2D)
E – pearl (#9020-90)	◇ Cut (1) 3½" square (1E), (4) 5" x 2" pieces (2E), (4) 3½" x 2" pieces (3E), (56) 1¼" squares (4E) & (40) 1" squares (5E)

Piecing: All seams are ¼" unless noted. Press seams toward last unit added or as indicated.

1. Lay a 5E square face down on each 4A and 6B square; sew diagonally from corner to corner, trim ¼" from stitching line and press seam away from 5E.




2. Repeat with the 4E squares and the 2A and 3B squares.




3. Lay a 5E square face down on one end of each 3A piece; sew diagonally as shown, trim ¼" from stitching line and press seam away from 5E. Repeat with (4) 5B pieces, the 4B pieces and the 4C pieces.

4. Repeat with the 4E squares and the 1A pieces, (4) 2B pieces, the 1B pieces, (4) 2C pieces, the 1C pieces and the 1D pieces.




5. Lay a 5E square face down on one end of each 5B piece; sew diagonally as shown, trim ¼" from stitching line and press seam away from 5E. Repeat with the 5C pieces.



6. Repeat with the 4E squares and the remaining (4) 2B pieces, the remaining (4) 2C pieces, the 3C pieces and the 2D pieces.



7. Arrange the remaining 5E squares and the units from steps 1, 3 and 5 as shown. Sew together as shown, making (4) A/B blocks and (4) B/C blocks.




8. Similarly, arrange the remaining 4E squares and the units from steps 2, 4 and 6 as shown. Sew together as shown, making (4) A/B/C blocks and (4) B/C/D blocks.



9. Sew an A/B block to each B/C block as shown and add to bottom of each A/B/C block, pressing seam toward A/B/C.

10. Sew a 3E piece to one E edge of each B/C/D block and a 2E piece to adjacent E edge, pressing seam toward 2E and 3E.

11. Arrange the segments from steps 9 and 10 with the 1E square as shown; sew into rows, then sew the rows together.



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
