

On the Water

Finished Size: 12" square

Skill level: Intermediate

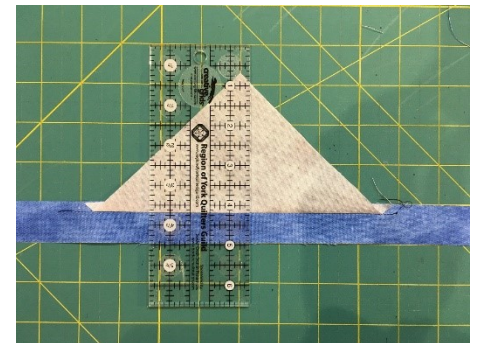
Fabrics used: Northcott's *Toscana* suede-look cotton

Fabric	Cutting Instructions	▣ = cut once diagonally	▤ = cut twice diagonally
1 – light gray (#9020-91)	◇ Cut (1) 7¼" square ▣ (1A) and (1) 4¾" square ▣ (1B)		
2 – charcoal (#9020-97)	◇ Cut (1) 1" x 6½" piece (2A) and (1) ¾" x 4¼" piece (2B)		
3 – tan (#9020-33)	◇ Cut (1) 8" square ▣ (3A) and (1) 4¾" square ▣ (3B)		
4 – blue (#9020-444)	◇ Cut (1) 7⅞" square ▣ (4A), (1) 4¾" square (4B), (1) 5⅞" square ▣ (4C), (1) 3⅞" square ▣ (4D), (1) 3¼" square ▤ (4E), (1) 2⅞" square (4F), (2) 2" x 3⅞" pieces (4G), (1) 1" x 12" piece (4H), (1) ¾" x 8" piece (4i), (1) ¾" x 4¾" piece (4J) and (1) ¾" x 4⅞" piece (4K)		

Piecing: All seams are ¼" unless noted. Press seams in direction indicated in instructions.

1. Center and sew the 4H piece to long edge of a 1A triangle, sewing with 4H on top; press toward 1A and trim ends of 4H in line with short edges of 1A. Repeat with 1B and 4i piece.

2. Lay 1A unit on cutting mat, with 4H/4i along horizontal line as shown. Cut vertically, ¼" to the RIGHT of the Fabric 1 triangle tip.



3. Insert a 2A strip between 1A units, aligning 4G edges with end of strip; press toward 2A. Repeat with the 2B strip and the 1B units.

4. Sew a 3A triangle onto 4G edge, pressing seam toward 3A. Repeat with a 3B triangle, centering it on the 4i edge of the 4i/1B unit.

5. Lay the 4B square face down on the 3A corner; sew diagonally as shown, then trim ¼" beyond seam, and press toward 3A. Repeat with the 4F square, adding it to the 3B corner triangle.

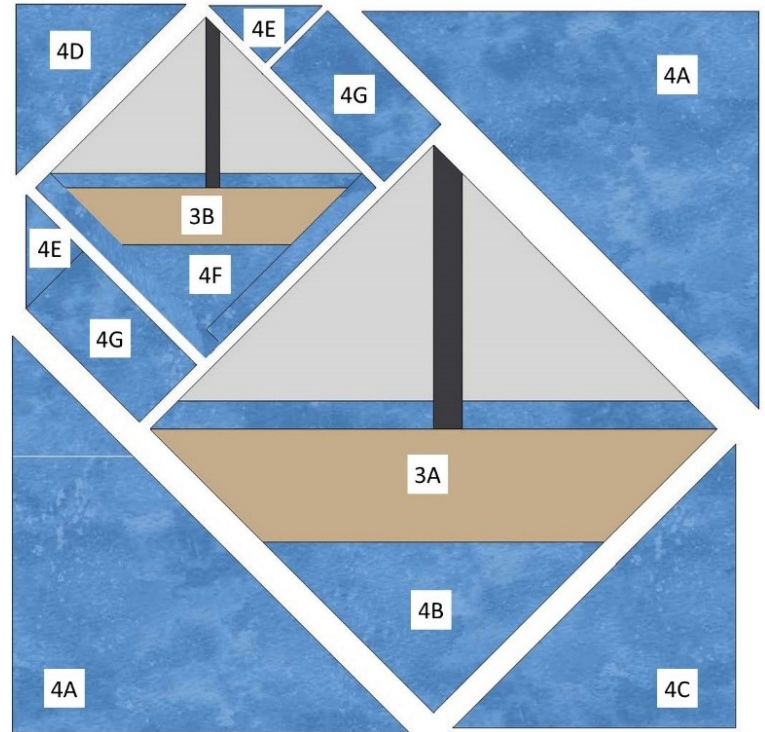
6. Trim 1B/3B block to 4¾" and 1A/3A block to 7⅞" if required.

7. Add a 4J piece to one 3B/4F edge, pressing seam toward 3B/4F, then add the 4K piece to remaining 3B/4F edge.

8. Sew a 4E triangle onto one end of each 4G piece as shown; add to opposite edges of block.

9. Center and sew a 4D triangle to 1B edge and a 4C triangle to 3A/4B edge; finger-press seams toward 3A.

10. Center and sew a 4A triangle to remaining edges (top right and bottom left), pressing seams toward center.
