Quilt patterns using efficient time-saving methods

Finished Size: 12" square

Skill level: Beginner

Fabrics used: Banyan Batiks Essentials and others (or choose your favorite

food fabrics)

Fabric	Cutting Instructions	□= cut once diagonally	⊠= cut twice diagonally
1 –background - putty	♦ Cut 1 strip 2" x wof; cut into (2) 12½" x 1½" pieces (1a) and (2) 12½" x 1" pieces (1b).		
(#81300-11)	♦ Cut 2 strips 1¾" x wof; trim to 25" (1c).		
2 – skewer - midnight	♦ Cut (1) 1" x 25" piece (2a)		
(#81000-998)			
3 – red (#80741-24)	♦ Cut (9) 3½" x 2" piece	s (3a)	
4 – orange (#80530-58)	♦ Cut (5) 3½" x 1½" pieces (4a)		
5 – green (#80144-67)	♦ Cut (4) 3½" x 1½" pied	ces (5a)	

Piecing: All seams are ¼" unless noted. Press seams in direction indicated in instructions.


1. Sew a 1c piece to long edges of the 2a piece; press seam toward 2a.




- 2. Cut 1c/2a unit into (6) 1½" sections and (15) 1" sections.
- 3. Select (3) 3a pieces, (2) 4a pieces and (1) 5a piece, along with (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " 1c/2a sections and (5) 1" 1c/2a

sections. Arrange in a row as shown.


4. Sew into a row, pressing seams toward 3, 4 and 5. Make 2 units.





5. Select the remaining 1c/2a units and pieces of 3, 4 and 5. Arrange in a row as shown; sew together, pressing seams toward 3, 4 and 5.

6. Arrange the sections from step 4 above and below the section from step 5. Insert a 1a piece between sections and a 1b piece at top and bottom edges as shown. Sew together, pressing seams toward 1a and 1b.
