

Hawaiian Vibes

Finished Size: 12" square
Skill level: Confident beginner

Fabrics used: Banyan Batik's Island Vibes 2 by Linda Hahn

Fabric	Cutting Instructions
A –guitar - (#80800-72 pink print)	♦ Cut 1 piece using Template A (join 1A and 2A prior to cutting), adding
	seam allowance
B – neck & hole (#81300-99 black)	♦ Cut (1) 6" square and 1 piece using Template B, adding seam
	allowance
C – background (#80802-72 green print)	♦ Cut (1) 12½" square
Heavy gold-colored thread or cord	



1. Pin 6" Fabric B square in bottom left corner of Fabric C square, aligning outer edges.

2. Press curved edges of Fabric A piece under ¼". <u>Tip:</u> Stitch a scant ¼" from edges and press just beyond stitching line. On inside curve (next to Fabric B square), snip seam allowance to allow pressed edge to lay flat. Place A in bottom left corner of Fabric C square on top of 6"



B square, having straight edges of A aligned with outer edges of C, and invisibly machineor hand-stitch in place using matching thread. To reduce bulk, trim away the portion of Fabric C that is behind the circle and guitar, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

3. Press long edges of Template B piece under ¼". Also press the * end under ¼". Using block image as a guide, place in top right corner of Fabric C square on top of the guitar piece and having the non-pressed pointed end of B aligned with top right corner of C. Invisibly machine- or hand-stitch in place using matching thread.



4. Draw 4 equidistant parallel lines from top right to bottom left corner, spacing them across the Fabric B neck. Using gold thread or cord, stitch/couch them along drawn lines.
