

# Celtic Knot

**Finished Size:** 12" square

**Skill level:** Confident beginner

**Fabrics used:** Toscana suede-look texture by Northcott

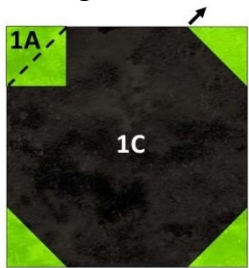
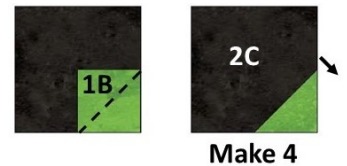
Label all pieces as indicated for easier assembly

Fabric	Cutting Instructions
<b>A</b> –lighter green (#9020-733)	◇ Cut (4) 3½" x 2" pieces (2A) and (8) 2" squares (1A).
<b>B</b> –darker green (#9020-73)	◇ Cut (4) 5" x 2" pieces (2B) and (4) 2" squares (1B).
<b>C</b> – background - (black #9020-99)	◇ Cut (1) 6½" square (1C), (4) 3½" squares (2C) and (4) 3½" x 2" pieces (3C)

**Piecing:** All seams ¼". Press toward lighter fabric unless indicated.

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of each 1B square.

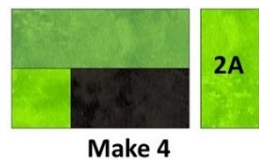
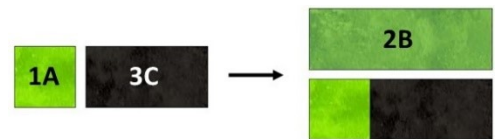
2. Lay a 1B square face down in 1 corner of each 2C piece as shown; sew along diagonal line and trim ¼" beyond line. Press seam toward 1B.



3. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of (4) 1A squares.

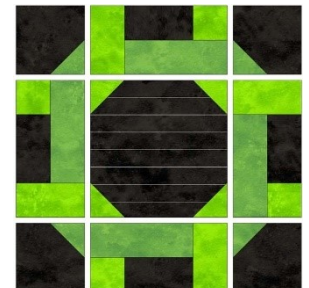
4. Lay a 1A square face down in each corner of the 1C piece as shown; sew along diagonal line and trim ¼" beyond line. Press seam toward 1A.

5. Sew a 1A square to one end of each 3C piece. Sew to one long edge of each 2B piece as shown at right; press seam toward 2B. Make (4).



6. Add a 2A piece to one end of each 2B unit as shown at left. Make (4).

7. Select the 1C unit. Add a unit from step 6 on each edge and a unit from step 2 in each corner, having the Fabric C edge(s) of units along outer edges. Sew into rows, then sew the rows together, pressing seams toward step 6 units.



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
