

Butter Dominoes

Finished Size: 12" square

Skill level: Confident beginner

Fabrics used: Toscana suede-look texture by Northcott

Label all pieces as indicated for easier assembly

▣ = cut once diagonally

Fabric	Cutting Instructions
A –dark brown (#9020-360 espresso)	◇ Cut (4) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares ▣ (A).
B –pale yellow (#9020-50 buttercup)	◇ Cut (2) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares ▣(1B), (4) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1" pieces (2B) and (4) 1" squares (3B).
C – light brown (#9020-36 chocolate)	◇ Cut (2) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (1C), (4) 3" squares (2C) and (4) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" pieces (3C)
D – pink (#9020-23 cotton candy)	◇ Cut (4) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares ▣ (D).

Piecing: All seams $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press toward darker fabric unless indicated.

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of each 3B and 2C square.

2. Sew an A triangle to each 1B triangle along long edge, pressing seam toward A.

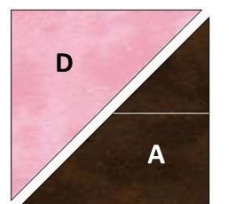
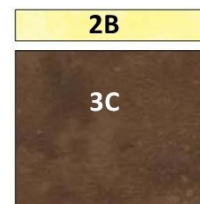
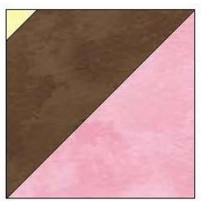
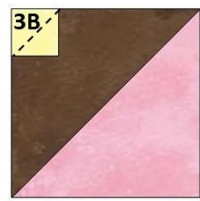
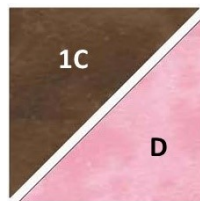
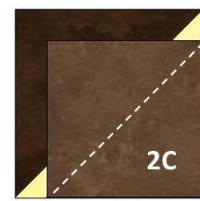
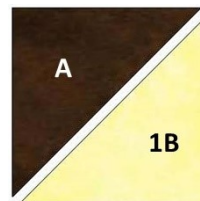
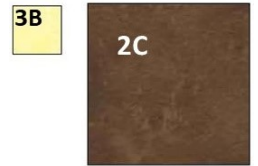
3. Lay a 2C square face down in 1B corner of unit above as shown; sew diagonally along line, trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from seam and press seam toward corner.

4. Sew a D triangle to each 1C triangle along long edge; press seam toward C.

5. Lay a 3B square in C corner of unit above as shown; sew diagonally along line, trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from seam and press seam toward C.

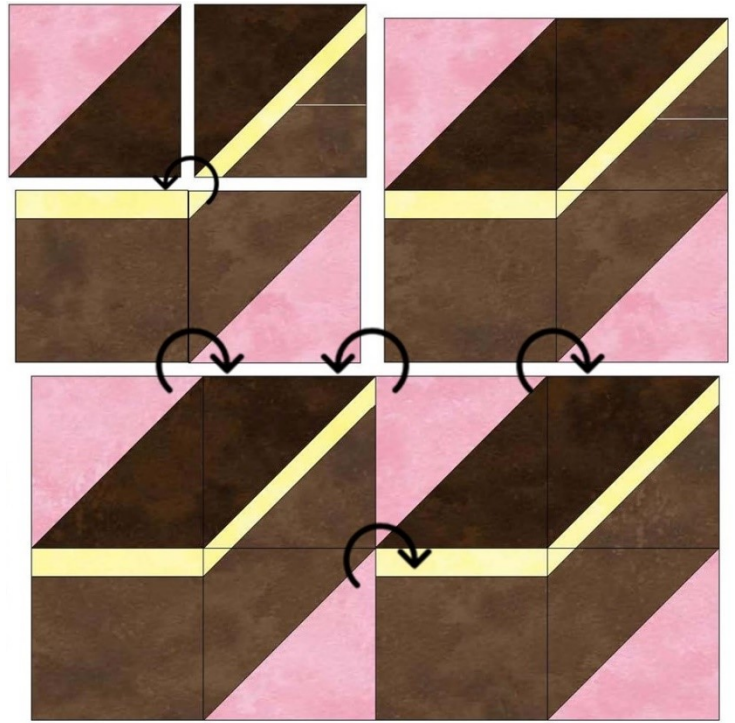
6. Sew a 3C piece to each 2B piece; press seam toward C. Make 4 units.

7. Sew a D triangle to each remaining A triangle, pressing seam toward A; make 4 units.



8. Select a unit from step 3, 5, 6 and 7. Arrange in 2 rows of 2 as shown in upper left corner of diagram at right; sew into rows then sew rows together. Repeat with remaining pieces to make (4) 6½" square units.

9. Similarly, sew the square units from step 8 into 2 rows of 2. Block should measure 12½" edge-to-edge.
