Finished Size: 12" square (12½" edge-to-edge)

Skill level: Intermediate

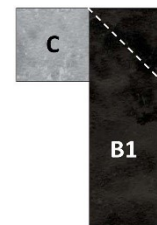
Fabrics used: Toscana suede-look texture and Color Play by Northcott

Label all pieces as indicated for easier assembly

Fabric	Cutting Instructions
A –blue (#9020-45)	◇ Cut (1) 12½" x 2½" piece (A1) and (2) 3½" squares (A2)
B –black (#9020-99)	◇ Cut (1) 9½" x 3½" piece (B1), (1) 6½" x 1" piece (B2), (1) 5½" x 1" piece (B3), (1) 4½" x 1" piece (B4) and (1) 3½" x 1" piece (B5)
C – medium gray (#9020-93)	◇ Cut (1) 6½" x 3½" piece (C)
D – cream (#9020-110)	◇ Cut (2) 6½" x 1" pieces (D1), (2) 5" x 1" pieces (D2), (2) 1½" squares (D3) & (16) 1" squares (D4)
E –yellow (#9020-52)	◇ Cut (1) 3½" x 4" piece (E)
F –gold (#9020-53)	◇ Cut (2) 5" x 1½" pieces (F1), (1) 3½" x 1" piece (F2) and (1) 2½" x 1" piece (F3)
G – pearl gray (#9020-91)	◇ Cut (1) 3½" x 1½" piece (G1) and (2) 1½" squares (G2)
H – putty (#81300-12)	◇ Cut (2) 2" x 1" pieces (H1), (2) 1½" x 1" pieces (H2) and (2) 1" squares (H3)
I – garden prints	◇ Cut (2) 2" squares (i1), (1) 2½" x 2" piece (i2) and (1) 2" x 1½" piece (i3)
J – mural (#DP24909-10)	◇ Cut (1) 6½" x 5½" piece, centering a heart wreath in the piece (J)

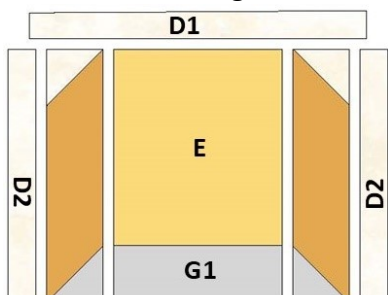
Piecing: All seams are ¼". Press toward darker fabric unless indicated.

1. Lay the B1 piece face down on the C piece, aligning edges. Sew diagonally from corner to corner; press seam toward B and trim ¼" beyond seam line.



2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on back of A2 squares. Lay a square on each end of above unit as shown; sew along diagonal line, press seam away from A and trim ¼" beyond seam line. Add the A1 piece to top edge. Unit should measure 12½" x 5½".

3. Similarly, draw a diagonal line on the backs of the D3 and G2 squares, lay squares at opposite ends of the F1 pieces as shown and sew along drawn lines. Note that one unit is the mirror image of the other unit.



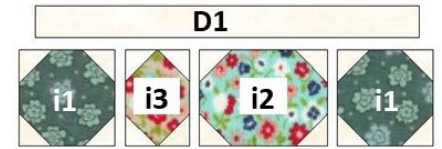
4. Sew G1 to E, then add the units from step 3 as shown, then add a D2 piece to each end, pressing seam toward center.

5. Add a D1 to top edge and the J piece to right edge; add to bottom of roof section.

6. Select the H pieces and the remaining B pieces. Add the respective H pieces to each end of the B3, B4 and B5 pieces, then sew together to make a section that is 2½" x 6½".

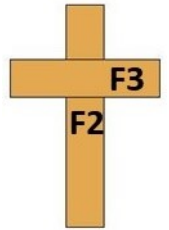


7. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each D4 square. Lay face down in each corner of the i1, i2 and i3 pieces, sew diagonally and press seam toward i.



8. Arrange in a row, then sew together, adding a D1 piece to top edge. Sew section to right edge of steps section, then add to bottom edge of door/mural section.

9. Press under ¼" on raw edges of the F2 and F3 pieces. Using image as a guide, pin to roof to form a cross and invisibly hand- or machine-stitch in place.



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
