

## Hearts Entwined

for Quilt Block Mania May 2023

Finished Size: $12^{\prime \prime}$ square ( $122^{1 / 2 \prime}$ edge-to-edge)
Skill level: Intermediate
Fabrics used: Toscana suede-look texture by Northcott

Label all pieces as indicated for easier assembly

| Fabric | Cutting Instructions |
| :---: | :---: |
| A -gray (\#9020-91 silver lining) | $\bigcirc$ Cut (2) $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (A1) and (2) $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (A2) |
| B -red (\#9020-231 Valentino), <br> C - light purple (\#9020-830 lilac), <br>  <br> E - pink (\#9020-23 cotton candy) | $\diamond$ From each fabric, cut (2) $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips (B1, C1, D1, E1) and (2) pieces using Template (B2, C2, D2, E2) |

Piecing: All seams are $1 / 1 /$. Press toward darker fabric unless indicated.

1. Select a B1 strip and an E1 strip; sew together along long edge, pressing seam toward $B$. Cut into (8) $11 / 2$ " segments.


2. Repeat with a B 1 and C 1 pair, a C 1 and D 1 pair and a D 1 and E 1 pair, pressing seams toward $B / D$ and cutting each set into (8) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments.
3. Select $4 B / C$ segments and $4 B / E$ segments. Arrange in 4 rows of

4. Similarly, select $4 B / C$ segments and $4 C / D$ segments, and sew together for top right quadrant, pressing toward $B / D$.
5. Likewise, select 4 C/D segments and $4 \mathrm{D} / \mathrm{E}$ segments, and sew together as shown at left for bottom right quadrant.
6. Finally, select the remaining $4 \mathrm{~B} / \mathrm{E}$ segments and $4 \mathrm{D} / \mathrm{E}$ segments, and sew together as shown
at left for bottom left quadrant.
7. Sew the 4 quadrants together in 2 rows of 2 , matching seams.

8. Press the curved edge of each $\mathrm{B} 2, \mathrm{C} 2, \mathrm{D} 2$ and E 2 piece under $1 / 4$ ". Pin 1 set onto the A 2 pieces as shown, aligning raw edges and leaving $1 / 4$ " of Fabric A each end; invisibly hand- or machine-applique in place. Add to sides of quadrant section as shown below.

9. Pin remaining set of $\mathrm{B} 2, \mathrm{C} 2, \mathrm{D} 2$ and E 2 pieces onto the A 1 pieces as shown at left, leaving $21 /{ }^{\prime \prime \prime}$ of Fabric A on each end; invisibly stitch in place, then add to top and bottom edges.
