

## PARTY GLAM

Finished Size: $12^{\prime \prime}$ square ( $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ edge-to-edge)
Skill level: Intermediate
Fabrics used: Toscana suede-look texture by Northcott
$\square=$ cut once diagonally

| Fabric | Cutting Instructions |
| :---: | :---: |
| A -red (\#9020-24 red) | $\diamond$ Cut 1 piece using T1 (A1), 1 piece using T2 (A2) and (1) $2^{1 ⁄ 212}$ square (A3). |
| B -wine (\#9020-26 hot sauce) | $\diamond$ Cut 1 piece using T3 (B). |
| C - black (\#9020-99 ebony) | $\diamond$ Cut 1 piece using T4 (C). |
| D - pearl (\#9020-111 champagne) | $\bigcirc$ Cut (9) $11 / 2 / 2$ squares (D). |
| ```E -background (#9020-93 going grey)``` | $\diamond$ Cut (1) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ piece (E1), (1) $57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square $\square(E 2),(1) 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square $\square(E 3)$, (6) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ pieces (E4), (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ pieces (E5), (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (E6), (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ pieces (E7), (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ piece (E8), (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece (E9), (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (E10), (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece (E11), (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (E12), (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares (E13), (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (E14), (3) $1^{\prime \prime}$ squares (E15), 1 piece using T5 (E16) and 1 piece using T6 (E17). |

Piecing: All seams are $1 / 4 \prime$. Press toward darker fabric unless indicated.
Tip for aligning patches for sewing: When you have 2 patches to be sewn together and they are sloped at opposite $45^{\circ}$ angles, they are correctly aligned when they meet at the $1 / 4$ " seam line as shown at right.


When you have 2 patches to be sewn together and only one is sloped at a $45^{\circ}$ angle, they are correctly aligned when they meet $3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ from the edge as shown at right. However, sew them together with a $1 / 4 \prime$ seam.

Shoe section: $12^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 6^{\prime \prime}$ high ( $121^{1 / 2 \prime}$ wide $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ high edge-to-edge)

1. Lay an E15 square face down in 2 adjacent corners of A3; sew diagonally from corner to corner of E15 as shown, trim $1 / 4$ from seam and press seam toward A. Similarly, sew an E15 diagonally to corner
 of A2 as shown.
2. Arrange the E16, C and E 17 pieces in a row as shown; sew together, pressing seams toward C to make a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ heel unit.

3. Sew $\mathrm{A} 1, \mathrm{~B}$ and an E 2 together as shown at left, aligning top and bottom edges; finger-press seams toward $A$.
4. Sew E1 to right (E2) edge of A1/E2 unit.
5. Sew an E12 to square end of A2 piece; add unit to bottom of A1/E1 unit, aligning it at both ends. Fingerpress seam toward A2.
6. Add an E3 triangle to A1/A2 edge of unit. Segment should measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
7. Sew the step 2 unit to the step 1 unit, pressing seam

Step 4
 toward A.
8. Sew the step 7 unit to the step 6 segment, matching A seams; press seams toward step 6 segment.

## Pearls section:

9. Sew the $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric E pieces to end(s) of D squares as shown to make 9 pieced strips, pressing seams toward D.
10. Arrange the pieced strips with the E4 pieces, inserting E4 pieces between the $3^{\text {rd }}$ to $9^{\text {th }}$ strips. Sew together, pressing seams toward pieced strips. Section should
 measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
