| A -red (\#9020-24 red) | $\diamond$ Cut (2) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$ pieces (A1), (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece (A2) and (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (A3). |
| B - orange (\#9020-571 monarch) | $\checkmark$ Cut (2) $6112^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (B1), (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (B2) and (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (B3). |
| C - yellow (\#9020-52 yellow brick road) | $\bigcirc$ Cut (1) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece (C1) and (2) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces (C2) |
| D - wine (\#9020-26 hot sauce) | $\bigcirc$ Cut (1) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ piece (D1), (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece (D2), (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece (D3), (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece (D4) and (3) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (D5). |
| E-background (\#9020-110 porcelain) |  |

Piecing: All seams are $1 / 4$ ". Press toward darker fabric unless indicated.

M unit: 1. Diagonally sew the $A 3$ squares to adjacent corners of an E2 piece; trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ beyond seam line and press seam toward A. Similarly, sew an E3 square to adjacent corners of A2; trim and press seams toward A.
2. Sew the A3 unit to plain end of A2, adding an E1 to opposite end of A2. Sew an A1 to each long edge, pressing seams toward A1. Unit should measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.




A unit: 3. Diagonally sew the B 3 squares to adjacent corners of an E2 piece; trim $1 / 4$ " beyond seam line and press seam toward B.
Sew an E3 to corner of each B1 as shown to make mirror-image B1 units.
4. Sew a B2 to opposite edges of B3 unit, adding an E2 as shown. Sew a B1 unit to opposite long edges, noting orientation of B1 units; press seams toward B1. Unit should measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.


K unit: 5. Following diagram at left, diagonally sew an E1 to opposite corners of each C2 to make 2 mirror-image units, trimming $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ beyond seam line. Sew together, then add C1 piece to left edge, pressing toward C1. Unit should measure $61 / 2 \prime$ square.

R unit: 6. Diagonally sew a $D 5$ to adjacent edges of an E2; trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ beyond seam line and press seam toward D. Similarly, sew an E3 to adjacent edges of D3 as shown.
Sew a D5 to short edge of E2 unit, adding D4 to
 one long edge and D3 unit to opposite long edge.
7. Diagonally sew an E1 to one corner and an E3 to opposite corner of D2 as shown. Sew E3 edge to bottom edge of D3 unit and add D1 to left (D4) edge of unit, pressing
 seam toward D1. Unit should measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.

8. Arrange the $M, A, K$ and $R$ units in 2 rows of 2 . Sew into rows, then sew rows together. Block should measure $12 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ square.
